





2022 Churchwide Assembly Voting Members

The Churchwide Assembly meets triennially in regular session, and the next regular session is scheduled to meet during the week of August 8, 2022, in Columbus, Ohio. Voting members are chosen locally from across the United States, Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands, representing the diverse communities, congregations, synods, perspectives and geographic contexts of the ELCA. Together with other leaders of the ELCA, and guided by the Holy Spirit, they discuss the work of the church in the world and make decisions reflecting the challenges we face and the strengths we all bring to loving and serving our neighbors in the name of Jesus Christ, locally and globally. Over the course of the assembly, voting members:

- •Hear reports and review the work of churchwide officers, leaders and units;
- •Receive and consider proposals from synod assemblies;
- •Elect officers, board members and other leaders as specified by the constitution or bylaws;
- •Establish ELCA churchwide policy;
- ·Worship together;
- ·Adopt a budget; and
- •Conduct other business related to the ELCA churchwide organization.

The outcome of the Synod Vice-president election will determine the available openings for voting members of the churchwide assembly from our synod. The synod assembly can vote for two non-rostered persons who are men and two non-rostered persons who are women among the churchwide assembly inclusion categories, so the gender of the VP, who must be a non-rostered person, will determine how many additional persons we can elect in those two categories.

As a result, the final grouping of those nominated to be voting members of the churchwide assembly will take place after the election of the Synod Vice-President and will be communicated to the voting members of the synod assembly.
